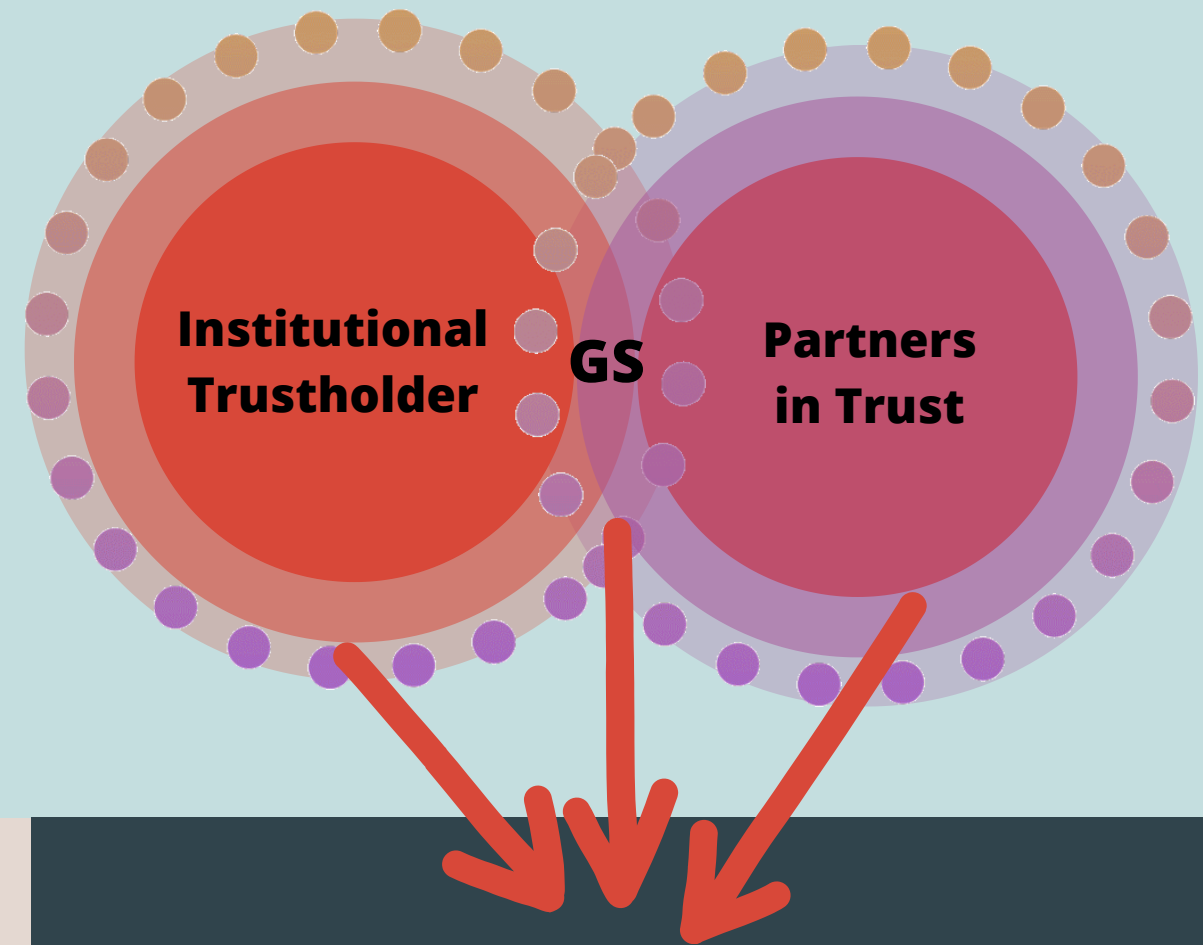
GOVERNANCE AT A GLANCE

ROLES & RELATIONSHIPS

Governance is not top-down, but layered and interconnected. The concentric circles reflect a non-centralized, relationship-driven model...



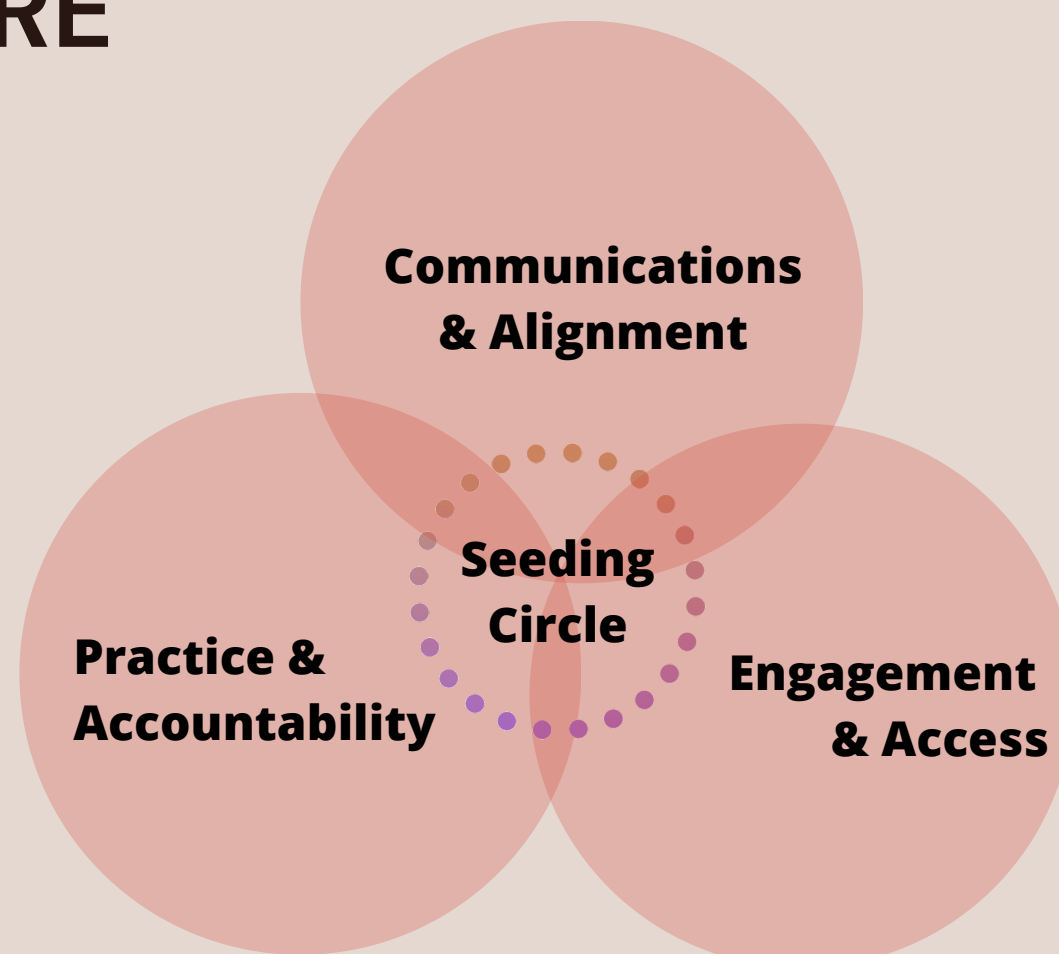
The **Governance Steward (GS)** is a neutral, community-approved relational strategist paid position.

Partners in Trust are individuals or organizations (tenants or not) who hold an ongoing relationship with the space and actively contribute to its culture, governance, and shared purpose.

The **Institutional Trust Holder**, represented by NBS, acts as the initial catalyst, providing backbone support while creating space for others to lead.

A PHASED APPROACH TO THE STRUCTURE

The model begins with the **Seeding Circle**. Once foundations are in place and the group has built initial trust and practice, the model transitions into three interdependent governance circles...
